#### Description of the organisation

'Emphasys Centre' was established in 1998 and is operating as a highly successful 'Education, ICT Training (VET) and Research Centre, approved by the Cyprus Ministry of

Education, Culture, Youth and Sport (MOECYS). Its vision is to offer high quality lifelong learning opportunities in the field of ICT to learners of all ages in order to upgrade their lives,

ensure inclusion, access and participation in the digitalized economy.

Emphasys is adequately staffed by 12 F/T and 4 P/T committed and highly qualified professionals, both researchers and teachers, with extensive experience in thematic areas relevant

to the organisation's expertise covering a wide range of areas such as IT, Computer Science, Business, Psychology, Sociology, Logistics, Graphic Design, Architecture, Law,

Environmental etc.

Emphasys comprises of four main directorates:

- 1) Education Directorate which offers:
- Validated and certified IT courses accredited by national and EU examination boards such as the Cyprus Computer Society (ECDL EQF Level 3-4), the MOECYS (Pancyprian IT

exams – EQF Level 5), Cambridge University (GCE A Level Computer Science) etc.

- Professional qualification for employment, as well as qualification to enter National and EU universities.
- Career guidance and counseling services to young people and students, as well as counseling and special support to all learners according to their needs (Early School Leavers,

Young unemployed people, Special Educational Needs, etc.).

- Organization of seminars, presentation, discussions, mobility (local-regional) in cooperation with established bodies (e.g. Bioethics National Committee, CCS) for various issues of concern of our target groups.
- 2) ICT Training Directorate which is active both at the national/regional and EU level through the various training courses/ seminars/ summer schools/ mobilities/ labs etc. offered to

different target groups such as students/ young people, as well as professionals (adults, teachers, youth workers, adult educators, seniors, youth etc.). Emphasys is actively involved in

the design and implementation of various courses (digital and employability courses) for professional development or in-service training offered by established organizations such as

the Ministries, Semi-public authorities etc. Three sub-units are established targeting the digital needs of the labour market and bridging the gap between education and the world of

work, while promoting the acquisition of STEAM skills problem solving and computational logic:

- The STEAM UNIT which is fully equipped with high tech tools in order to offer project-driven related courses to young people combining Robotics, 3D Design and Printing using the

Craftbot+ 3D Printer, and Coding through Video Game design using state of the art Virtual Reality Headsets such as the Oculus Rift S guided with 'Lego Education Trainer' instructors.

- The ONE STOP DIGITAL SUPPORT CENTRE provides various opportunities both on-line and off-line for the acquisition of digital, employability and entrepreneurial skills for adults

and young people. Targeted seminars, experts' visits and tutorials, career advisors' presentations etc. are organized aiming to upgrade their skills for the digitalized economy and the

labour market. A wide selection of tools and platforms is available for people to use.

- European Training UNIT which focuses on the organization and provision of KA1 Learning Mobility Courses for Teachers, Adult Educators, Young People, Youth Workers, VET

trainers etc. in various fields such as 'Coding and Robotics for Educators', 'Technology Tools in the classroom', 'STEAM for teenagers', 'Internet Security and Safety on line' etc.

Opportunities for internships, job shadowing and teaching practice are also offered with the guidance and support of our experienced mentors.

3) Research Directorate which cooperates closely with several organizations for the preparation, implementation and management of various EU projects in different programmes,

such as the Erasmus+ in the field of Education, VET, Sports and youth, AMIF, Justice and other national programmes. Emphasys is a member of the DLEARN Digital Learning Network, a highly active network promoting digital literacy and acquisition, with other 25 organisations from Europe. Two of its projects have been awarded as a GOOD PRACTICE

PROJECTS by the European Commission (CODE@YOUTH – Youth Sector-CYPRUS and V-UPGRATES – VET Sector-GERMANY).

4) Software Development Directorate which is involved in the design, development, pilot-testing and evaluation of various e-learning tools, platforms, websites, applications and

assessment portals etc. based on the needs of the various project being implemented by the organization.

# Experience and Expertise of the organization in the project's subject area

The areas relevant to this project are:

- Emphasys has previous experience with the field of DEMENTIA as partner in the FORGET-ME-NOT Erasmus+ VET project completed in August 2019 with an award from the UK

NA. The target group was carers of Dementia sufferers both formal (social workers, nurses) and non-formal (members of the family) and the focus was on investigating how the

recovery of memories could support sufferers through the use of on-line tools and a custom-made platform.

- It works closely with adult educators/trainers, social workers, teachers, seniors, adults, professionals, young people and youth workers offering upskilling programmes for the acquisition of specific competences or for personal development, such as ICT courses, safety on line, internet addiction, employability, soft skills, empowerment etc.
- It organizes the ONE STOP SUPPORT CENTRE, both on-site as well as in other places (e.g. Elderly People's House, Community Centre) where it offers opportunities to various groups of adults for LLL or intergenerational learning, targeting mainly vulnerable groups of adults in order to acquire specific skills or for upskilling/reskilling training for a sustainable future. It also creates opportunities for visits, job shadowing, internships etc. in order to have a first-hand experience.

In addition, Emphasys is developing and managing LMS platforms offering e-learning opportunities as well as e-tools and e-assessment procedures. Its experience with the assessment and validation methodology of the Open Badges is substantial and it can be fully used for the project in order to offer transparent, valid and visible skills for the target group.
